In January of 2006 I visited Harborside Nursing Home and they warmly welcomed me to sing and play guitar for the residents. I went every Monday and although there were some days I would walk through the front door and feel a heaviness and sadness – always after I started singing, the atmosphere changed and a joy and peace would sweep through the room. I could tell that not only the residents but also the staff could feel it! It was the Lord’s presence. It is like He comes and just lays a beautiful comforting blanket upon the room. Music (especially music that praises God) just has that effect. And still to this day as I visit Southwood Nursing Home – the same experience repeats itself each time and it is so awesome! Also, I have met some wonderful elderly residents who have shared their life stories with me and their wisdom and their love for Jesus. Sometimes serving the Lord is as simple as holding a hand and listening... their faces just light up as they tell about the past or about their grandchildren and great-grandchildren. It is such a blessing to get to know each one.

Last November another door opened when I was told of a need at the Crisis Pregnancy Center and I felt the Lord telling me I should help. When a client comes in to the center for services a written record is created that needs to be entered into the computer database for short-term reference to the client’s activities and for long-term statistics about the activity of the center. Having previous database experience, I decided to give it a try. And it has been so rewarding. Although the computer work is a bit tedious, as you enter the information you learn the stories of many young people’s lives and your heart just aches for them. Also, you appreciate how important and needed is the work at the CPC. Every day, lost young women and men are given counsel and hope and are shown that somebody does care and for the moms-to-be that somebody cares about the lives of their babies.

Some people wonder why I appear to be happy all the time and although that is not entirely true, I do know that I am very blessed and part of that comes from doing volunteer work. I encourage everyone to not be afraid to say those three little words... “Yes I can” ... and let your little light shine!
